

Creating a Trauma Informed Community

TIC Action Plan 2024

Goals identified from the TIC Committee for 2024

- 1. Establish guidelines for Trauma Informed Care Certification for individuals and organizations.
 - a. Each committee member will attend a 2-hour trauma certification course. The certification is valid for one year and will need to be renewed annually.
- 2. Increase the number of individuals trained to facilitate trauma informed care training.
 - a. The committee will host a 'train the trainer' to increase the number of individuals trained to facilitate trauma training throughout the community. Each individual trained will be tasked with provided minimum 3 training courses per year.
- 3. Develop a county wide training schedule on trauma informed care.
 - a. Committee will identify organizations or businesses interested in offering TIC training to their staff.
- 4. Create specific training on trauma as requested from committee and other interested organizations.
 - a. Committee will create a standard trauma training; however, additional trainings will be created to provide information related to specific topics as requested.
- 5. Utilize and promote 211 as the community resource guide that includes all county resources for community agencies and their clients and the central repository of trauma -informed services.
 - a. The committee will utilize and promote the use of 211 as a community resource guide.
- 6. Incorporate Sources of Strength approaches into efforts implemented in the community.
 - a. The committee will discuss and strategize how to incorporate Sources of Strength into the work being implemented throughout the year.
